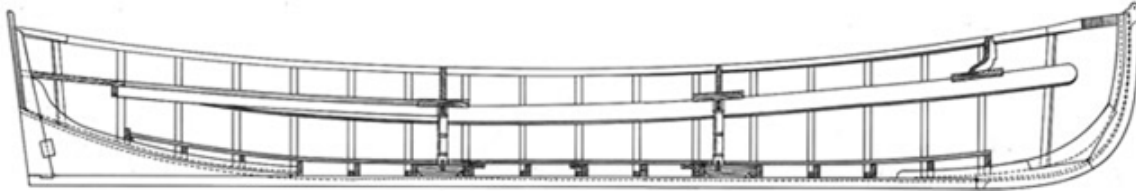
APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

1. Please complete, sign and return this entire Application for admission.
2. Include a **\$25** application fee. A check or money order is requested payable to **The Friends of the Boat School**. This fee is non-refundable and cannot be applied to any other Boat School charges.
3. All students must submit a final high school transcript and official transcript(s) of all post secondary education. If you received a GED, you must submit a copy of the state recognized high school equivalency certificate and test scores.
4. Prior to attending The Boat School all students born after December 31, 1956 must submit immunization records for:
 - A. **Diphtheria/Tetanus**
 - B. **Measles**
 - C. **Rubella (German Measles)**
 - D. **Mumps****This is a State of Maine Requirement.**

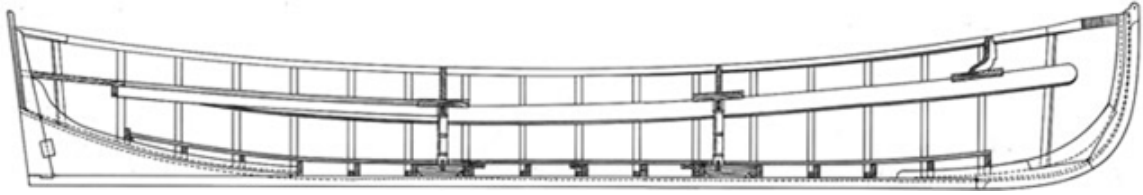

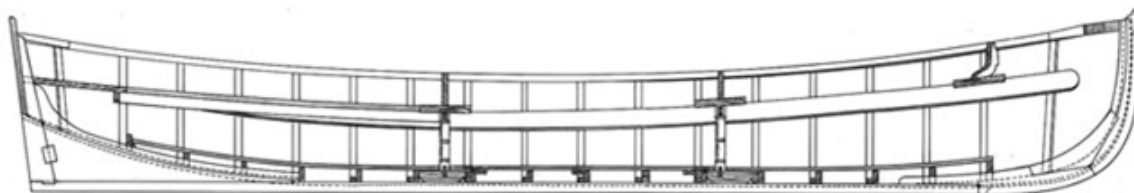
